ROAD NAME ASSIGNMENT NEW/REPLACEMENT SIGNS

PURPOSE:

Pursuant to Section 4.2 of the Otsego County Addressing Ordinance, it is the responsibility of the Otsego County Road Commission to provide and/or approve road names for all public and private roads in Otsego County with the exception of roads within cities or incorporated villages.

POLICY:

Upon requesting a new road name, the applicant will need to complete and submit an Application for Public/Private Road Name/Sign Install form to the Otsego County Road Commission.

Upon submitting the Application for Public/Private Road Name/Sign Install form for private road name assignment for new and replacement signs, the applicant will be responsible for the cost of the road name sign (includes the cost of the sign, post, bracket and installation by the road commission). The road commission must receive payment in full for the sign before the road name assignment application can continue to be processed. The cost for assignment of a road name/sign install for public roads shall be the responsibility of the road commission.

In order of preference, a minimum of three road names must be submitted by the applicant - no proper names.

The applicant must designate the location of the road and whether the road is public or private.

The applicant is responsible for obtaining the signatures of all individuals who own habitable structures along the road to be named. Each of those individuals must sign the application to indicate their agreement with the name.

EXCEPTION: If the road itself is owned by one or more individuals, only those who have ownership may sign the form (property owners who use the road to access their property have no right to sign the form, only the actual owner(s) have the legal right to name the road).

If the road to be named is part of an association, the approval of the association must also be obtained before the request can be approved. It is not the responsibility of the road commission to determine if an association is involved.

There is to be a minimum of two habitable structures on the road before it can be named (can be waived by authorization of the Equalization Department).

Once the Application for Public/Private Road Name/Sign Install form has been accepted by the Otsego County Road Commission, the road name will be determined. The Otsego County Road Commission shall be the sole final authority for the assignment of a road name.
