#### DESCRIPTION

Pursuant to the Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act, P.A. 2 of 1968, as amended, the Otsego County Board of Road Commissioners ("Board") approved an operating budget for fiscal year commencing January 1, 2023, and ending December 31, 2023. Budget amendments are necessary from time-to-time and at year-end when a deviation from the original general appropriations act occurs and new information is available. The Board is authorized by statue to amend the budget from the original general appropriations act as necessary. Below is a description of the cost centers in the FY 2023 Budget that require amendments:

Capital Outlay – Road Equipment: Increase \$100,000.00: The overage on capital outlay – road equipment is due to added purchased equipment for necessary operational activities.

Net Administrative Expense – Increase \$250,000.00: Administrative (Office Salary, Finance Manager, Manager) wages plus fringe benefits are in this account, as well as the everyday expense of running an office.

Other – Debt Principal Payments: Increase \$225,000.00: The overage on debt principal payments is due to paying off two (2) leases early.
